Questions for WP7

For the pilot in WP7 we were able to develop questions that could be included in the Dutch Parliamentary Election Survey. We experiment both with the political narratives, as varying independent variable conditions, as well as with whom solidarity is expressed, as varying dependent variable conditions.

The survey questions are developed to test the following research questions:

To what extent and in which ways do diverse political narratives foster interethnic working class solidarity and interethnic working class cooperation? More specifically, we are interested in understanding if a political narrative that merges social class and ethnicity increases the willingness to support the improvement of incomes of an ethnic diverse working class (interethnic class solidarity), and willingness to work together for the raising of incomes of an ethnic diverse working class (interethnic class cooperation), among people in the working class, with and without a migration background.

The preregistration gives the full models that will be tested.

Questions are implemented in Dutch. Here both the translations and the original Dutch wording are given.
